

Journalist Visa

Visa Type: Sticker Visa Stamped on Passport
Validity: Valid for 3 Months
Allowed Stay: Single Entry | 30 Days from the day of Entry

Apply for a Journalist Visa if you are travelling to Nigeria for:-

- Purpose of Journalism.

Important Information:-

- Documents not in English must be submitted with a certified translated copy.
- All letters should be typed, signed and dated & must be addressed to the Nigerian high commission New Delhi.
- Non-Indian passport holder – must provide legal residence (resident visa/permit).

Documents Required for Journalist Visa

1. Passport/Travel Document a minimum of 6 months validity. Must have two blank facing pages If non-Indian passport holder please see below for additional notes.
2. Two recent passport sized photographs with white background.
3. A letter of invitation from Nigeria, from your Nigerian contacts. This must be addressed to the Nigerian High Commission New Delhi. It must be on letter headed paper stating the address of the company, the reason for the visit and must be signed and dated by the inviter.
4. A letter from the organizations the applicant works for, this must be addressed to the Nigerian High Commission New Delhi. It must be on letter headed paper stating the address of the company, the reason for the visit and must be signed and dated by a senior member of staff at the company. This cannot be signed by the applicant.
5. Itinerary, listing any equipment you are taking with you to Nigerian, and detailing the schedule you are keeping during the duration of your stay.
