

On Arrival Business Visa

Nigeria Visa on Arrival is a class of short visit visa issued at the port of entry. The facility is available to frequently travelled High Net Worth Investors and Intending Visitors who may not be able to obtain visa at the Nigerian Missions/Embassies in their countries of residence due to the absence of a Nigerian mission in those countries or exigencies of urgent business travels.

Visa Type: Paper Visa, Needs to be printed from email.

Validity: Valid for 14 Days

Allowed Stay: Single Entry | 30 Days from the day of Entry

Apply for an On Arrival Business Visa if you are travelling to Nigeria for:-

- Conference (attending only)
- Business Discussions
- Business Meetings
- Meetings with Government Officials
- Academic / Educational / Institutions Parastatals
- NGO – Non-Government Organisations (if invited by or attending meetings)
- Meetings with Business Partners
- Business Related Issues.

Important Information:-

- Documents not in English must be submitted with a certified translated copy.
- All letters should be typed, signed and dated & must be addressed to the Nigerian high commission New Delhi.
- Non-Indian passport holder – must provide legal residence (resident visa/permit).

Documents Required for On Arrival Business Visa

1. Scan copy of the applicant's passport in .jpg format. This must be clear.
2. One passport size digital photograph white background.
3. Request letter duly stamped and signed from the Nigeria Company. This letter must have details of accommodation of applicant and letter should address to "The Comptroller General of Immigration, NIS HQ, Abuja Nigeria." requesting for on arrival business visa. This request letter must have the Nigeria Company's letterhead.
4. Copy of Certificate Incorporation Of the Nigerian Company.
5. Introduction Letter from Applicant Indian company side address to The Comptroller General of Immigration, NIS HQ, Abuja Nigeria. This Introduction Letter must have the name of the applicant, his/her nationality, passport number, the purpose of the visit, proposed date of visit, proposed port of entry.
6. Confirm tickets.

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
