

Temporary Work Permit (TWP)

Visa Type: Sticker Visa Stamped on Passport
Allowed Stay: Single Entry | 60 Days from the day of Issue

Apply for a Temporary Work Permit (TWP) if you are travelling to Nigeria (from 1 day up to 2 months) for any type of following work:-

- Installation
- Providing Training
- Commissioning
- Inspections
- Auditing
- Accounting
- Review Development
- Upgrading of Company
- Consultancy Work
- Visiting Facilities (on site visit)

If you are travelling to Nigeria for any of the above reasons for more than 2 months, you are advised to apply for a Subject to Regularization (STR) Visa.

Important Information:-

- Documents not in English must be submitted with a certified translated copy.
- All letters should be typed, signed and dated & must be addressed to the Nigerian high commission New Delhi.
- Non-Indian passport holder – must provide legal residence (resident visa/permit).

Documents Required for TWP

1. Passport/Travel Document a minimum of 6 months validity. Must have two blank facing pages If non-Indian passport holder please see below for additional notes.
2. Two recent passport sized photographs with white background.
3. A letter of invitation from Host Company in Nigeria. This must be addressed to the Nigerian High Commission New Delhi. It must be on letter headed paper stating the address of the company, The reason for the visit must be stated and accepting full immigration and financial responsibility on behalf of the applicant duration his/her stay.
4. Photocopy of inviter's international passport data page.
5. Certificate of Incorporation of the Host Company in Nigeria.
6. A copy of Cable Gram for TWP, with the applicants name clearly stated on it.
